VENUE

Makuhari Messe, Chiba Prefecture

Located approximately 35 minutes by bus from Narita International airport and 30-60 minutes from by train or bus from Central Tokyo, Makuhari Messe is an international convention complex. The Makuhari Event Hall, which is one of the Messe's major facilities, is the main venue of the 2013 World Championship. The Event Hall has an acoustically excellent 3,098 square meter arena with a seating capacity of approximately 5000 persons.

ACCOMMODATIONS

National Olympics Memorial Youth Center (NYC), Tokyo is surrounded by greenery and quite atmosphere by the neighboring Meiji Jingu shrine and Yoyogi Park. This major physical education, sports and accommodation complex has extensive facilities. The Center was developed as the Olympic Village for the Tokyo Olympics in 1964. A major new construction was made in 1991 and it has become a world class youth and cultural activity center.

LOCAL TRANSPORTATION

Buses/Truck

During the period of the Championship from August 8th to August 12th, buses for travelling and trucks for transporting musical instruments will be arranged as follows:

From Narita International Airport to The accommodation place (NYC).

Round Trip between NYC and the Event Hall.

From NYC to Narita International Airport

Buses and trucks are available only for travelling and transportation between above mentioned places and do not include the use for sightseeing and other private services.

REHEARSALS

The place for rehearsal is the **Event Hall,** which is the same place to be used for the Championship. It is available during of August 8th.afternoon and 9th morning time for bands rehearsals.

PARTICIPATION FEE

Package Price Japanese Yen 20,000 per person

(Equivalent to US \$ 250 using exchange rate of one US Dollar = Yen 80)

Upon receipt of this amount in Yen from each band, the Organizing Committee will provide the member of each band with the accommodation for 4 nights (August 8^{th} –August 11^{th}) at NYC , meals (from dinner of August 8^{th} to breakfast of August 12^{th}) and bus/truck transportation explained in above Local Transportation.

GEOGRAPHIC INFORMATION

Chiba City lies east of the Tokyo Metropolitan area. Makuhari area of Chiba city faces with Tokyo Bay and has easy access both with Narita International Airport and with the central Tokyo. Disneyland and Disney Sea are located at the distance of only 20 minute drive from Makuhari area. Train connection between Tokyo Central is also easy. The average temperature during August is around 30 centigrade.
